Denim Rug From Old Blue Jeans

Materials needed: Old Blue Jeans Heavy Muslin

Thread...since stitching doesn't show, this is good place to use up those odd colors of thread.

This project has no close tolerances. If measurements are a little off, everything should still work.

General instructions: Cut your muslin to the desired size. My pictures are of just a small portion. A nice size would be about the size of a small throw rug. Make a narrow hem around all 4 sides.

Cut your denim strips all the same width. I used 2 inches. Cut them any length that you are able to cut from your scraps.

You can piece the short ones together or cut the long ones to fit. Just butt the ends together, and stitch as one. When cutting the fringe, it doesn't have to be real even slashes. Just be sure you don't cut through the stitches.
