

HONEY-DO HAMMER

For that To-Do List for your Hubby

Materials and tools:

Pine Board 1X6X12 inches

Snapper type Clothespin

Acrylic paint in medium brown and black

White Medium Paint Pen

Wood Glue

Sandpaper

Scroll Saw (or Jig Saw

Optional equipment.....Router

ZigZag Hanger

Using template from page 2, trace hammer onto pine board. Cut out and sand all surfaces lightly. Slightly round edges of the handle only. You can use a router with a round over bit for this step, but if you don't have a router, just sand the sharp edge until slightly rounded.

Mix medium brown paint, approximately one part paint to 5 parts water, in a shallow container. Dip a rag or sponge into mixture and apply to the front, back and edges of the hammer. Let set for a couple minutes and then wipe dry with a soft cloth. Let dry completely. Paint the hammer head and the clothespin black and let dry. Glue the clothespin in place, using the picture as a guide. Print "Honey Do" on the hammer head with the white paint pen.

Attach hanger to back of hammer head as shown.
