Pasta Angel Ornament

This is an ornament that the kids can help make. A nice addition to the tree. My version is rather unique since I use a tree branch for the body, a bead from an old car seat for the head, and popcorn for the hair.

supplies : tree branch about the size of your finger

Bead for the head....any bead will do

Popcorn hair

Bowtie for wings

Elbow macaroni for the wings

Gold Chenille stem for Halo



about 12 inches of red ribbon & a small piece of cardstock for the book

Hot glue or thick tacky white glue White acrylic paint and small paintbrush

Sharpies --- red and black for face features

Glue bead to top of branch. Add popcorn for the hair, arranging around the face. Glue Bowtie pasta to the back for wings, and elbow macaroni to the sides for arms. At this point, paint the entire angel white. Using picture as a guide, make eyes and mouth with sharpies. tie a bow and glue under the chin, Cut a piece of card stock about ½ inch X 1 inch and fold in half for the song book. wrap the chenille stem around a sharpie to form a halo, and cut to size. Glue to the top of the head. Glue ribbon to top of head inside the halo to form the hanger.
